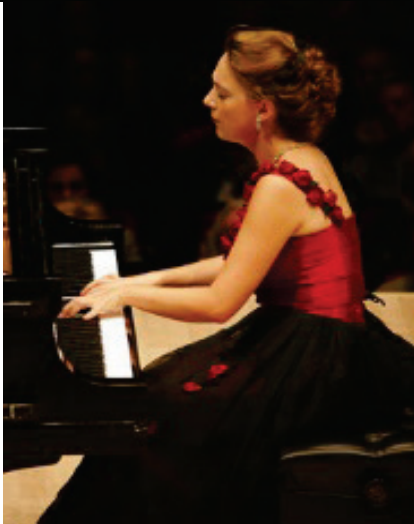


## *In Concert:*

Born in Moscow, Ms. Grineva began playing the piano at the age of five and came to America in her teens to study. Since 1998, she has performed in Carnegie Hall thirteen times. She performs throughout the United States, Europe, South America, and Asia. **BYRON DUCKWALL** - conductor, cellist Byron Duckwall is principal cellist of the Exultate Chamber Orchestra. He is the former principal cellist of the Orquestra Simfunica Estadual de Sao Paulo under Eleazar de Carvahlo. In his early twenties, Byron was on the faculty of the Center For New Music, a Rockefeller Foundation Group. Later he played for the Metropolitan Opera Association in New York City. Byron has played in concert with such notable musicians as Luciano Pavarotti, Placido Domingo, Pinchas Zuckerman, Arnold Steinhardt, and many others.
